#### GBCA & GECA: precast is more sustainable

We decided to arrange a meeting with GBCA and GECA to discuss the benefits of precast and how those may be recognised by both organisations.

#### National Code review

Sarah will make contact with WorkCover Queensland who have now been tasked with updating the National Code.

#### Roads authorities: TMR & Austroads Prequal

- Sarah will talk to QDTMR about the intent of the meeting in late June to review MRTS70.

- Members are invited to nominate to review a draft of the Austroads National Prequalification System for Precast - <u>contact Sarah</u> if interested.

#### Standards: AS3850 and civil; AS5131

- Bill Wright is going to investigate whether the CCF would be interested in jointly funding a consultant to prepare a draft Part 3 of AS3850 which would apply to civil construction.

- We put in a submission to Standards Australia on AS5131 Structural Steelwork, recommending inclusion of provisions in the Standard that are consistent with AS3850, particularly in relation to the requirement for an Erection Designer. This would ensure that precast is not disadvantaged compared with steel.

#### Training for factory staff

- Delta Corporation has generously agreed to allow NP to develop a generic precast version of their Manufactured Mineral Products training material. Jason Walsh will be obtaining a quote on this and Sarah will liase with Kathy Barakis on whether funding is available. We will then seek interest from members.

- At a later stage we will also look into developing training material for office staff on understanding the Australian Standards and safety requirements that apply to precast.
