Getting there

Train

It takes less than 20 minutes to train from Central Station to Lidcombe Station, with over 100 services each day between 5:55 am and 11:38 pm.

The Sprint service, operated by CityRail, travels between Lidcombe and Olympic Park Stations daily, every 10 minutes, and only takes 5 minutes.

The Olympic Park Station is situated directly opposite The Dome.

Car

Sydney Olympic Park is surrounded by Parramatta Road, M4 Motorway, Homebush Bay Drive and Silverwater Road. For short visits, there are ample two hour free parking spaces located on Grand Parade, Olympic Boulevard and Dawn Fraser Avenue. There are also over 400 accessible car parking spaces.

Carparks P1, P5 and P6 are in close proximity to Sydney Showground. The rate is \$5 per hour, up to a maximum fee of \$25 per day.

Bus

- 401 Lidcombe to Olympic Park Station via Mons Street (approx. every 20 min during peak)
- 450 Hurstville to Burwood & Sydney Olympic Park
- 525 Between Parramatta and Burwood via UWS, Rydalmere, Ermington, Silverwater, Newington and Sydney Olympic Park.
- 526 Sydney Olympic Park Wharf to Burwood via the Sydney Olympic Park.
 - 533 Chatswood to Sydney Olympic Park via Mowbray Rd, North Ryde and Rhodes.
