August Members' Meeting - Highlights

If you didn't manage to come along to the Gold Coast meeting, here's a summary of what we heard about and discussed:

- Members' Education We heard from Ultrafloor's Kevin Crompton (The art of negotiation), Ehab Hamed from UNSW (Researching sandwich panels), Reid's Jeff Stratford (The possibilities of graphic concrete), David Baggs from Global GreenTag (EPDs and Green Star), Damien Richards from Humes (The journey into lean manufacturing), and Sean O'Sullivan from Moray & Agnew (Contract Law & Security of Payments: An update). Note if you couldn't be at the meeting or would like a copy of any of these presentations, please contact Megan.
- Projects We heard about Skytrain from Hanson's John Hewitt Thanks for sharing John!
- Members' Spotlight Craig Zinn was interviewed by Richard.
- Full time Technical Services Co-ordinator to better serve members, we will be going ahead with plans to recruit someone with precast knowledge and preferably with engineering qualifications. The person will perform tasks previously undertaken by Peter Webb as well as some new tasks and will relieve Sarah from some of her work to enable an increased focus on member recruitment. The office will also be relocated to a larger premises to accommodate.
- **Peter Webb** was formally thanked for his contribution and we look forward to his continued involvement and contribution as a Professional Associate Individual member.
- Steel Certification Working Group update an NP position will be drafted (supporting ACRS but advocating steel compliance by <u>any one</u> of the four options detailed in AS 4671; not supporting the need for precasters who cut and bend ACRS certified steel to again themselves be ACRS certified) and the position will be discussed with Austroads.
- Austroads National Prequalification update we will request a copy of the latest version and then meet with Austroads.
- ACRS Bob Connell advised that ACRS is running seminars in all cities promoting the use of ACRS certified steel.
- **Exclusion zones** Jeff Stratford suggested reviewing Part 2 of the new AS 3850 regarding exclusion zones; it was agreed that exclusion zones should be dealt with in an individual project's JSA (due to differences between site conditions, states and builders).
- **Bar chair standard** a new standard has been published which demands load ratings for bar chairs. An 18 month transition period applies.
- AS 4671 revision of the standard is overdue and Standards Australia has asked for committee input as to whether the standard needs reviewing. We will follow up with our rep Gary Connah.
- Jeff Stratford we presented Jeff with a Certificate of Meritorious Service and pen, in recognition for his work on AS 3850.
- National Code following publication of AS 3850, we will make contact with Safe Work Australia to discuss progress on revision of the National Code of Practice.
- Erection Design there was a discussion around the business opportunity for engineers wishing to provide erection design services.
- Case studies we showed the case studies that have been produced since the last meeting.
- **PR coverage** we showed the coverage we have received in Sourceable, Outdoor Design Source, Roads & Civil magazine and Construction Engineering Australia magazine.
