AS 1314:2003 Prestressing anchorages

URGENT FEEDBACK NEEDED - Does it need review?




Standards Australia is currently assessing all standards which are more than 10 years old. Because *AS 1314:3002 Prestressing anchorages* was last revised in 2003, Standards is seeking input on whether the standard should be:

1. **Reconfirmed without changes** (the document is technically valid, relevant and compatible with current expectations regarding safety, quality and environmental impact. Reconfirmation involves retaining the original standard number and year with the year of reconfirmation identified e.g. **AS xxxx—1992** (Reconfirmed 2015).;
2. **Withdrawn** (the document is not up-to-date technically; no longer reflects current practice; is not suitable for new and existing applications; or is not compatible with current national views and expectations, but will still be available for sale from SAI Global);
3. **Made obsolescent** (the document is not required for new equipment, does not reflect current practice, but is retained to provide for servicing of existing equipment or requirements); or
4. **Revised** (this will require a review proposal from the committee or other stakeholders).
