As we have previously advised, Standards Australia is currently assessing all standards which are more than 10 years old. Standards is seeking input on whether the above standards should be:

1. **Reconfirmed without changes** (the document is technically valid, relevant and compatible with current expectations regarding safety, quality and environmental impact. Reconfirmation involves retaining the original standard number and year with the year of reconfirmation identified e.g. AS xxxx—1992 Reconfirmed 2015).;
