Call for NP rep to develop new GECA standard

We have been asked to provide a representative to participate in the Technical Advisory Group (TAG) for the development of the GECA (Good Environmental Choice Australia) **Cement and Concrete Products Standard**. The standard will reflect and recognise best practice in the marketplace today.

GECA is an independent, non-for-profit organisation that runs the internationally recognised Environmental Choice Australia Ecolabelling Program. They aim to help people choose goods and services which are better for the environment and people by allowing their logo to be displayed on products which meet their stringent criteria for environmental and social preferability.

What you are signing up for:

The TAG will provide input to the draft over approximately six weeks, which should constitute no more than six hours of your time. Communications will take place via email or telephone to develop a Draft for Public Comment which will be published on the GECA website.

The TAG consultation progresses in three phases (total 6 weeks, not necessarily consecutive weeks), as follows:

1. Identification of key areas to be addressed by the standard (approx. 2 weeks);
2. Development of appropriate limits and methods of testing; and (approx. 3 weeks); and
3. Final review of proposed criteria (approx. 1 week).
