## AS 1597.1-2010 - Incorporating Amendment No.1, August 2018

There has recently been an amendment to the Australian Standard for small box culverts, AS 1597.1:2010.

The recent Amendment added eight more box culvert sizes to Table 2.5 (extract below). Additionally, the <u>removal</u> of note 2 "Other size culverts may be made to a specific order" was a key part of the amendment.

Nominal sizes added to Table 2.5 are shown below.

## PREFERRED INTERNAL DIMENSIONS—CULVERT UNITS

The intent of the amendment is to increase the likelihood that culverts will be made to stock, rather than made to order. This change is expected to benefit both manufacturers and asset owners.

Members who choose to align with the changes may wish to amend culvert documentation and advise sales staff.
