Publication of AS 3600 Concrete Structures

AS 3600 Concrete Structures was recently published. This Standard sets out minimum requirements for the design and construction of concrete building structures and members that contain reinforcing steel or tendons, or both.

This latest revision also contains the newly-developed Section 17.7 Prefabricated Concrete Structures, as well as a host of other new sections.
