Reminder - Public comment period: Amendment 1 to AS 3850.1

Prefabricated concrete elements, Part 1: General Requirements

Comments to NP by 10th October for 24th October submission close date.

The public comment period is now open for the Amendment 1 to AS 3850.1. This is your opportunity to review the Standard and put forward any suggestions for changes.

Suggestions can be made in one of two ways:

- Review the draft [here](#), place your comment in this [table](#), and send your comments to [Sean](#) by 10th October, who will collect responses and submit on behalf of members.
